

## SOMIEDO THE CANTABRIAN BROWN BEAR



This trip has a minimum length of three days.

Usually our trips begin and end in Madrid. For other points of departure and return do not hesitate to contact us.

The price of this trip will be determined by the number of people on the excursion, the type of accommodation chosen and the days of the excursion. For more information do not hesitate to contact us.

Recommended season: Spring and autumn are the best time for its observation although they can be seen at all times of the year except in winter.

### **DESCRIPCIÓN DEL VIAJE:**

This is a trip focused mainly on the observation of the Cantabrian Brown Bear.

As Bears are more active at sunrise and sunset, on the way to Asturias we will make a stop in Villafáfila to observe the Great Bustard and then we will go to see a colony of Rook. On this same day we will arrive to Somiedo before sunset to make the first wait for the Cantabrian Brown Bear.

There will be two waits per day in the best observation sites for this emblematic species. Sunrise and sunset are the most propitious moments for its sighting.

The rest of the day there will do excursions to see the Birds that live in this ecosystem and its wonderful landscapes.

#### **TARGET SOECIES:**

#### Mammals:

Cantabrian Brown Bear, Iberian Wolf, Cantabrian Shamois, Bobcat, Red Fox, Roe and Red Deer.

#### Birds

Egyptian and Griffon Vulture, Northern Goshawk, Golden and Short-toed Eagle, European Honey-buzzard, Peregrine Falcon, Common Kestrel, Alpine Swift, Eurasian Wryneck, Black and Middle Spotted Woodpecker, Crag Martin, Tree, Tawny and Water Pipit, Deeper, Dunnock, Alpine Accentor, Black Redstart, Redstart, Bluethroat, Northern Wheatear, Rock Thrush, Crested and Marsh Tit, Eurasian Treecreeper, Red-backed Shrike, Eurasian Jay, Red-billed and Yellow-billed Chough, Snowfinch, Citril Finch, Yellowhammer, Rock Bunting, among others. Sightings of listed species depends on the year's time of the visit.
